Purpose of Meeting:

Due to the new COVID-19 state and county regulations that are required for our community to open the pool for the 2020 season the Plantations Two Board of Directors conducted a meeting with all its pool members. The meeting was held in order to present vital information that everyone needed to be aware of before visiting the pool during the 2020 season.

Attached to these notes is copy of the Plantations Two Pool Welcome Letter which was sent to all the pool members. Also attached is a copy of the Presentation that was given at the meeting and posted on the web page for everyone reference.

After the presentation to the Zoom meeting attendees the board then opened the floor for questions and answers about the pool opening and new guidelines.

Meeting adjourned after there were no more pool questions.

We're Opening!

We're ready to welcome our members back for the 2020 season!

Please have patience with the pool committee and Georgetown Aquatics as we adjust to the new state and local regulations. We look forward to seeing you at the pool this summer!

Based on Montgomery County Guidelines we can open our pool with a reduced capacity which will be 60 guests, per session. Please review the county press release allowing pools to open as part of Phase 2 at

There is still a lot to do between now and opening day and we are continuing to work with Georgetown Aquatics to make it happen!

Here are some general guidelines about the upcoming season:

- There will be one entrance and one exit to avoid cross traffic
- Masks will need to be worn upon entry, and on the pool deck, but not in the water
- Check-in will be required, along with a verbal health confirmation
- A waiver will need to be signed. Please see our website (www.plantationstwo.com) to download the waiver.
- A Greeter at the pool entrance will collect the waivers, review health questions, and keep a count of pool members.
- Guests will not be allowed due to reduced capacity, in order to ensure all our members have access to the pool.
- There will be no group functions or parties at allowed at the pool this season.
- Pool chairs and umbrellas will not be available. You will need to bring your own chairs.
- Tables will be on the deck in assigned locations to assist in distancing. Other areas will also be marked reminding guests to maintain social distancing.
- Members can only bring small snacks and beverages. Ice cream will not be sold, and food delivery will not be allowed during Phase 2.
- Wading/baby pool and Slide will be closed.
- There will be allotted session times for using the pool and between sessions all members will need to leave the facility.
- We are starting out with 4 sessions per day. They will be 1.5 hours with a 30-minute break for cleaning between each so that Georgetown Aquatics can conduct required sanitizing.
- Session times are: 12-1:30 pm; 2-3:30 pm; 4-5:30 pm; 6-7:30 pm and are subject to change if needed.

Understand this is new to all of us. Let's work together to have a great summer!

2020 Season Announcement

General

Safety

- Our overall goal this season is safety
- We will continuously be reviewing state and local regulations and health guidelines
- We are working closely with Georgetown Aquatics and Legal Counsel

Flexibility

- Regulations may change and we will need to respond to those changes
- We will respond to feedback from Georgetown and reserve the right to make modifications to the initial rules we publish
- Thank you for your patience, this is a very new process for everyone!

Requirements

- Patrons who wish to attend the pool will need to sign a waiver
 - Waiver per household that lists out the members of the household
 - Waiver will be available on the Plantations Two Website and should be brought to the pool, extras will be available at the pool (please bring your own pen)
 - Waivers must be brought to the pool by an adult
- Do not come to the pool if you are feeling sick
 - Upon entrance you will be asked a series of general health questions
- You will still need to scan in and the front desk with your pool tag. If you lost your pool tag from last year, replacements are \$10.
- Masks are required at all times except when in the water.

Requirements

- Only 60 people at the pool during any swim time slot
- Different entrance/exit points
- Patrons are required to maintain social distancing while visiting the pool.
- Swim slots will be 1.5 hours long.
 - For example a slot is 12-1:30 p.m. At 1:30, everyone in the pool and on the pool deck will be asked to exit so required cleaning and sanitization can be completed before the 2 p.m. slot begins
 - A slot is not 1.5 hours from the time you arrive
- Slots are first come/first serve. You can come return for a later slot if there is still available space
- Guests will not be allowed this season to ensure all members are able to have ample access to the pool
- We will have greeters at the entrance helping with questions, counts, and while inside the pool to help maintain social distancing and new guidelines

Requirements

- The wading/baby pool is closed for the season
- We will not be hosting parties/large gatherings at the pool this season
- We will have tables only but no seating or umbrellas available. Tables should not be moved as they denote ample social distancing.
- Patrons may bring their own chairs for personal use
- Patrons may bring beverages and small snacks to the pool. We are asking patrons to limit the amount of food brought to the pool and are not allowing food delivery this year.
- Pool toys will not be allowed or provided this year
- We are still gaining an understanding on the regulations around slide use and safety so currently the slide will be closed

Information

- Rules will be sent by email, provided on the Plantations website and available at the pool
- Signage will be available at the pool
- Additional information will be provided during the season if changes are needed
- Information regarding time slots will be posted at the pool and available on the website
- Note: Time slots may change based on feedback from Georgetown Aquatics
